Beginning December 26th, this exciting guided nature tour travels into Mexican waters to the wildlife sanctuary of the Coronado Islands. These pristine islands, 14 miles off the coast from San Diego are home to a wide variety of wildlife including sea lions, elephant seals, dolphins, brown boobies, oyster catchers and lots of other seabirds. In winter Gray Whales linger in the waters near the islands, resting on their journey south. Commentary includes naturalist interpretation and stories of the islands' history, its pirate past, slave ships, the old casino, the rum running days and more.

The trip begins with a cruise through San Diego Bay and a chance to see US Navy ships, international freighters, Historic Ballast Point and the Spanish Lighthouse atop Point Loma. Some trips offer special viewing of aquatic birds, and marine mammals within sight of the Naval Marine Mammal Research Center. Once offshore expect to see whales and other marine life while enjoying an interpretive narration provided by trained and knowledgeable staff.

BLUE WHALE CRUISES

Six Hour Cruises Depart 10 AM
June thru October

It's an incredible sight to see the largest animal to have ever inhabit the planet! Blue Whales, some as long as 100 feet in length and weighing up to 190 tons (380,000 pounds), are being sighted off the San Diego coast at nine to thirty miles. H&M Landing, in partnership with the San Diego Natural History Museum, has created a series of Blue Whale Cruises from San Diego Bay. The opportunity to view these offshore giants is available for a limited time each year. Dolphins, sea lions, sea birds and other marine life are experienced on every cruise. Humpback, minke and finback whales have been seen every season. Trip itinerary includes the Coronado Islands as time permits. All cruises feature commentary and interpretation by the San Diego Natural History Museum's trained volunteer staff of shipboard naturalists.
